Childhood cancer in Moldova

In 2023 around 400 000 families in the world will receive a cruel verdict that their child is diagnosed with cancer. 90 families will be in the Republic of Moldova.





- Country population 2,6 mln + 100 thousand refugees from Ukraine;
- Only one Pediatric Hematology Oncology Unit in the country;
- 34 beds;
- 7 medical doctors, 22 nurses and 14 auxiliary staff

Support for children with cancer

Institute of Oncology from Moldova

- Treatment for about 90 childhood cancer
 patients/year
 - malignant blood disorders
 - Solid tumors
- Types of treatment available:
 - Oncological surgery
 - Chemiotherapy
 - Radiotherapy
 - Treatment is free of change

- Tight collaboration with the Association "LifeWithout Leukemia".




